## JUSTIN STAHL SHOWCASE

**CAPITOL THEATRE, YORK, PA**

Justin Stahl is a native of Beech Grove, Indiana. Beginning at age five with the encouragement of his great-grandfather, Justin was mostly self-taught in piano and organ. His passion for music has reached many venues that have included accompanying for several choral departments, directing church music, playing for community theatre, and serving for nearly sixteen years in the Indiana Army National Guard's 38th Infantry Division Band.

Justin has most recently entertained thousands of patrons of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra in the last seven productions of their annual Yuletide Celebration, playing the 3/24 Wurlitzer installed at the Hilbert Circle Theatre. Theatre organ has always been a passion of Justin's and has taken him to performance venues across the country. He was a featured artist at the 59th ATOS Convention held in Indianapolis.

A graduate of Marian University with a Bachelor's degree in piano performance, Justin presently serves as the director of music for the Horizon Science Academy High School in Columbus, Ohio, while writing choral/instrumental arrangements for several choir departments. His approach and philosophy includes the continued promotion of the theatre organ by using a wide base of musical genres.

Justin Stahl will be our guest organist for our April 2<sup>nd</sup> showcase at the Capitol Theatre. Justin currently resides in Hilliard, OH, and this is his first time playing for SVTOS. He was a featured organist at the 2014 ATOS Convention held in Indianapolis, IN, and recently completed a tour in Australia. Because of his teaching schedule we have moved our usual time from the second to the first Monday of the month.

On Saturday April 14<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 PM, Don Kinnier will be accompanying the 1925 silent film, "The Eagle" starring Rodolph Valentino at the Capitol Theatre. "The Eagle" is a mix of action, comedy, drama, and romance. Tickets are \$7.00. This is the last film before the Capitol Theatre closes for renovations in May.


Our annual business meeting and election of officers will be held on Sunday May 6<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM at the Howard/Fenner residence in Lebanon, PA. It's election time again and all officers are up for election: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. We are thrilled to have Justin back for the third time.

We will have directions to The Howard/Fenner residence in the next newsletter. We will have our SVTOS meetings at this location until the Capitol Theatre reopens following their renovations.

The 2018 ATOS Convention will be held in Pasadena, CA, from June 29<sup>th</sup> thru July 3<sup>rd</sup> and promises to be a great convention with outstanding organs and artists.
