

BRETT MILLER is one of the youngest in a rare art form: an active organist, conductor and arranger who specializes in the art of silent film accompaniment. As an award-winning organist, he has continued his academic involvement and advocacy for the education and preservation of silent films through performing "live to picture." In 2021, he was appointed music director of the Empire Film and Media Ensemble, a non-profit based in Rochester, New York, that advocates for the education, performance and production of film music. He was recently appointed artistic director of the organization.



Brett shares a close relationship between the ensemble and the Beal Institute of Film Contemporary Media at the Eastman School of Music. Brett is currently working toward a Master's Degree in Orchestral Conducting at the Eastman School of Music at the University of Rochester.

Ken Sanders' Xmas Cake Recipe

KEN SANDERS kindly provided the delicious refreshments for the November meeting and several members asked for the recipe, and Ken graciously provided the following:

XMAS CAKE RECIPE

2 c. sugar 1 package raisins (15 oz.)

Scant tsp. salt 2 heaping tbls. bacon fryings (Crisco)

Scant ½ tsp. cloves 2 c. hot water

2 heaping tsp. cinnamon

- Put all ingredients in a pan / pot and bring to a rolling boil.
- Let it boil for 5 minutes. Let mixture completely cool.
- Add to the mixture: 1 heaping c. walnuts chopped, 1 c. cut up cherries,
 1tsp. baking soda dissolved in 2 tbls. very warm water, 3c. flour (1 c. at a time).
- Put into sprayed loaf pans (2/3 filled). Bake in a 350 oven for about 40 50 minutes.
- Check with a toothpick to make sure the cake is baked through.
