SVTOS ZOOM MEETING

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8TH @ 7:00 PM

Winter has arrived with all of its impacts. Here's hoping you and yours are doing well with your social distancing efforts.

SVTOS tradition is to have a relatively low profile in January and February with all of the winter travel issues and impacts. We did have an Open Console on January 15th at the Capitol Theatre. With Barry Howard hosting, it provided a convenient time to have my first face to face (distanced) meeting with the Appell Center's CEO Todd Fogdall and Barry to discuss the Chapter's goals for this year. Todd indicated that reopening of the Capitol would not happen until late in February or sometime in March, mostly due to the need to limit audience size and the unpredictable winter weather.

My goal for the meeting was to propose our approach to this fall's resumption of SVTOS meetings and events and discuss how we could coordinate an International Youth Silent Film Festival (IYSFF) event at the Capitol with the Appell Center's plans and educational outreach. To help engage with the IYSFF and local mid and high school programs, I need your input. That is, if you have any relationship (official or on a friendship basis) with local school boards or school management, particularly in the area of curriculum planning, please let me know. The IYSFF is planning an outreach effort this summer to interested educators and our area can become part of that effort with our input to them.

Several have indicated that a "catch-up on happenings" would be useful to break the isolation, so I will host a socially distanced Zoom SVTOS Chapter gathering on Monday evening, February 8th at 7:00 PM. It will be a way to share each other's status and review the year's calendar including ATOS Convention plans. (A link with an agenda will be sent on Saturday afternoon, February 6.)

Barry Howard reports several have already signed up for Open Console on February 15th, but a couple of times are still available.

Looking forward to catching up with everyone.
